They are finally making an appearance after months of waiting in the wings, while the "little guys", the Cru Bourgeois and Petit Châteaux, revealed their prices. You may remember our first offering. Few of the royalty were included.

The aristocrats are scarce this vintage. If a retailer did not buy the 2008 vintage their allocations may have been cut. We didn't, and they were. Few American retailers did and supplies of the 2009 vintage are quite limited all over the U.S. But Green's still has an impressive array of Bordeaux's finest; it is just not in great depth. That's why when you get this email you should respond immediately. "The race is not given to the swift." But that's the way to bet.

My tastings in early April in Bordeaux revealed some superb wines. Quality wise, 2009 is at least on a par with the other great vintage of the decade, 2005. Stylistically, it is quite different.

The best 2009's have more supple, opulent fruit than the 05's. They also have great balance, displaying a very refreshing nuance of acidity in their aftertastes. Moreover, there is plenty of tannin, necessary for long cellaring, but the ripe fruit masks its presence at the moment. The wines are absolutely delicious to drink NOW! Will they close up and become tough a year or so after bottling as most vintages do, I am not so sure. There are no easy benchmarks in the past to compare this year's wine against.

I do have my own personal theory on how the wines of this vintage might develop. Except for the bottle shock all wine goes through immediately after bottling, these wines may never really close up. They may drink deliciously upon release and evolve, in the case of the best wines, for decades, changing character, but never going through a dumb stage. It will be exciting to find out!

Quite frankly the wines of this vintage are going to be very popular. Demand is strong. Because I did not buy the 2008's, some of my quantities have been cut or, in a few cases, I will get zero. This is a round about way of telling you to act quickly. The prices on 2009 Bordeaux will probably never be lower, primarily due to a very favorable exchange rate, and the availability, at least in the U.S., will never be better. One popular chateau allocated only 500 cases to America, out of a total of 25,000 cases!
