It was my great pleasure, this past winter, to visit with Alexander Favier of the renowned Chante Cigale estate in Chateauneuf-du-Pape. Tasting his wines was an experience and I immediately wanted to place an order for as many cases as I could get allocated. Sadly, due to some prior commercial commitments, this turned out to be impossible. However, M.Favier had a plan B.

He created three cuvees for us under the label Reserve des Oliviers.

This is not the real name of the estate, but like some of the great offers you've had recently from Green's under fictitious labels, (Angel's Landing comes to mind for example), it is a superb value. Unfortunately I can't tell you where it is from as a condition of sale. I think I happened to be in the right place at the right time, as I got the impression he wanted to move out the last of some 2007's in stock and transition into the 2008's. Whatever the reason, you're the winner.

A blend of 65% Grenache, 20% Syrah, 10% Mourvedre, and 5% Cinsault, this wine has a bouquet of Provencal herbs, with licorice and black fruit aromas. The flavor is quite intense, with rich ripe fruit and an explosively long finish. This will age over the medium term but it is absolutely delicious for drinking now.-Green' Wine Buyer
