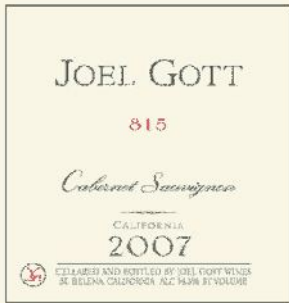

Park Lane Cabernet Sauvignon 2007 Sonoma County

This was one of our best selling California Cabernets last year. There is no real Park Lane Winery. As a condition of purchase, I can't tell you where it's from. You have obviously heard we are in a recession. Expensive California wine sales are down. A winery can cope with this situation one of two ways. They can lower the price on the real brand and hope to "juice" sales. However, this could permanently harm its image and commercial value. OR they can make a faux label and sell the wine off cheaper without harming their real brand name. Park Lane is a product of the latter alternative. You could spend \$40 at the winery for this wine, and I can't tell you which one it is, or \$14.99 at Green's. Same Juice. Take your pick.

The grapes for this wine are sourced from the Alexander Valley and Chalk Hill areas of Sonoma County. This is "high cotton" for a \$15 Cab. Hints of oak mingle with its cassis flavor. Very good fruit concentration, it is delicious now.- Michael Bishop, Green's Wine Buyer

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
