Bassermann-Jordan Riesling Trocken 2007

"Plump, with peach, nectarine, lemon and grapefruit notes. Has good cut, keeping it fresh and resonant through the finish...89 points."

Pavillon Blanc de Margaux 2005

"Intense citrus and tropical fruit aromas of warm grapefruit, lemon curd, pineapple and a fair amount of cedar. The rich, full bodied palate provides refreshing medium to high acidity balancing the concentrated toasted almond and lemon pie flavours. Long finish with a pleasant touch phenolic grip from the new oak. Just starting to be approachable. Drink now to 2020+...93 points."

Red Wines:

Ch Les Tuileries "Sense 5" Bordeaux Rouge 2005
Regular Price: \$12.99
Green's Cash Sale Price: \$5.99

This wine is a classic case of an ugly label being sold at a ridiculously expensive price (\$12.99.) Branded for another retailer as "Sense 5", whatever that means, it is really the product of a very reputable Bordeaux property named Chat. Les Tuileries. It is from a great Bordeaux vintage too, 2005.

Whether it was their high sale price (\$12.99) or the abysmal label, or both, the original retailer couldn't sell it, and the back stock languished in the wholesaler's warehouse. Green's has now acquired it and, though we could do nothing about the label, "right sized" the price to \$5.99.

The wine tastes delicious, particularly for something priced so modestly! A blend of 30% Cabernet Sauvignon, 40% Merlot, and 10% Cabernet Franc, it has a clean cherry-like rich fruit flavor on the palate with hints of herb and mint. This wine is very smooth and ready to drink now. - Green's Wine Buyer

Lafond Pinot Noir Santa Rita Hills 2005
Regular Price: \$23.99

"...one of the Santa Rita Hills oldest wineries, established in 1972...The aromas start out with barnyard and hay changing with time to a more mysterious composition of dark red fruits and anise. Sweet Jolly Rancher fruit dominates with cinnamon and chocolate notes. Elegant in style and readily appealing." - princeofpinot.com

Clos Trigueдина Cahors "The Black Wine" 2005
Regular Price: \$64.99

"A stylish Malbec, with luscious red cherry, huckleberry and dark plum flavors. Has a firm structure, with plenty of unctuous spice, mineral and dark chocolate notes that fill the long finish. Drink now through 2014. 100 cases imported...93 points." - *The Wine Spectator*

Green's Wine Buyer note: This is the finest, most complex Malbec I have ever tasted. From Cahors in France, the motherland of this grape variety, Argentina produces nothing quite like this wine. Its name, "The Black Wine," dates back to the Middle Ages when the local wine-producers heated some of the grape bunches or the "musts" to produce the so-called "black wines" of Cahors.



Clos Triguequina makes this cuvee the same old fashioned way. There were only 100 cases of this rare wine imported into the U.S. Green's owns 27% of the entire lot. Truly a rare experience and a steal too!

The 37-acre vineyard, situated within the Libourne city limits, includes some of the appellation's oldest vines...The 2001 is a worthy rival to the 2000...this vibrant red boasts a gorgeous bouquet of striking minerality intermixed with raspberries, blackberries, and hints of blueberries, espresso roast, and oak. Medium-bodied, elegant, and pure, with an intense mid-palate as well as a long finish...92 points." -Robert Parker *(Available at the Buford Highway store only)*

Ch Troplong Mondot St. Emlion Grand Cru Classe 1995
