This 100% Cabernet Sauvignon is made with estate-grown grapes sourced from Goose Ridge Vineyard. That's right, single-vineyard Cabernet from one of the world's great areas for this grape variety priced at \$7.99!

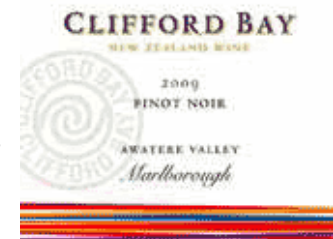
**Garnacha Carinena 2009

Green onion and white fruit in the aroma, this fresh, zesty dry white wine is medium-bodied, with flavors of apples and herbs. Lively and refreshing finish.





Cartlidge & Brown
Chardonnay North Coast 2010

56% sourced from Suisun Valley, an area just east of Napa, 40% Russian River Valley fruit, and 4% from the Sonoma County half of Carneros, these are "high cotton" districts for a \$9.99 bottle of wine. We agree with Robert Parker's assessment of Cartlidge & Brown: "The question that begs to be answered is why so many producers ignore what Cartlidge and Brown does better than just about anybody else in the state —produce fruit forward, pure, varietally correct, delicious wines."



I'Auriere Muscadet Sèvre & Maine sur Lie 2010
Green's Cash Price: \$9.99

Along with Vouvray, Muscadet is one of the few Loire Valley wines that one can readily find in the U.S. Let me explain the nomenclature on the label. "Sevre et Maine" is the best wine producing area, taking its name from the two rivers which define the district. "Sur Lie" indicates that the wine has been left on its lees for up to 6 months, over the winter, to give the wines extra body and complexity. Crisp and dry, a perfect choice for shellfish or fish. Great aperiff too.



Coppola Unoaked
Chardonnay California 2009

Apple and mild butterscotch aromas, this wine exudes fresh fruit on the palate with a nuance of nutmeg. Plenty of character and complexity for a wine in this low price category, its delicious!

Not sourced from the generic "hinterlands" of Burgundy as so many of these wines are that wear this modest title, Pascal declassified leftover bits of St. Romain, Auxey-Duresses, Monthelie, Chassagne Montrachet village and 1er Cru Boudriottes, Cotes de Nuits Villages and Morey St. Denis, blended them all together, and created a cuvee named "Avalon Bourgogne Rouge."

I had the luck to taste this in February 2010, just before bottling, and was absolutely blown away. Soft round dark fruit flavors, with a hint of chocolate in the aftertaste, the wine offers remarkable Burgundian character and complexity for a wine in its class. Drinks well now, though I think it will continue to develop for a couple of more years. - Michael Bishop, Green's Wine Buyer

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Vintage 2009 was as successful in Bordeaux as it was in Burgundy. One of the same observations hold true for both areas: you can find excellent wine at what are normally entry or medium quality levels. Cru Bourgeois that tastes as good as Grand Cru? Yes. Petit chateaux that reminds one of Bordeaux that normally costs 2-3 times as much. Absolutely!

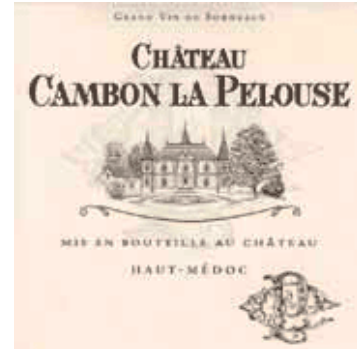

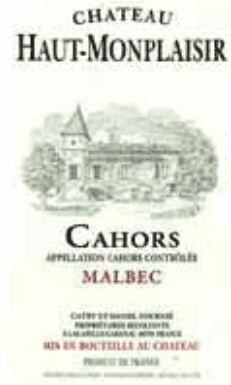
